

Report on TAAG's meeting on May 16, 2019

AGENCY REPORTS & UPDATES

1. Sherriff's Office –Srgt. Jason Carone
 - a. 334 calls for service resulting in 36 arrest
 - b. 2 deputies assigned to cannabis team – most action in the CA Valley area
2. Supervisorial District 1 – Vickie Janssen
 - a. Cannabis Amendment scheduled to go before the Board of Supervisors on June 6th
3. County Planning Department – Kate Shea
 - a. Cannabis Ordinance Amendment to go to Planning Commission on May 23 and to Board of Supervisors on June 6th
 - b. Accessory Dwelling Unit to go before Planning Commission on May 23 for discussion and at a future date to the Board of Supervisors.
 - c. Board of Supervisors makes the final decision; Planning Commission only makes recommendations to the Board of Supervisors concerning amendments to the Land Use Ordinance.

NEW BUSINESS

1. AT & T /Osborn for a Conditional Use Permit for a cell site/wireless communications facility consisting of a 28 x 55 fenced lease area for a 62' high faux water tank, ancillary equipment cabinet, and antennae at 4240 Rancho Road
 - a. TAAG unanimously recommends approval of the project
2. Semmes for a Subdivision to subdivide an existing parcel, 2.18 acres, at 1075 Rossi Road into 3 parcels.
