TCSD Update

- **Templeton Fire & Emergency Services** - Chief Tom Peterson implemented the 24/7 staffing on Saturday, October 31, 2020, after the passage of Measure A last year. In appreciation of the community's support for the Templeton Fire, the department hosted an open house at the station on Saturday, October 31.
- **TCSD Board of Directors** - All three incumbents were re-elected to another 4 year term on the TCSD Board; Pam Jardini, Navid Fardanesh, and Debra Logan.

TAAG BUSINESS

- 1. TAAG Boundary Expansion** - The Board discussed expanding TAAG's boundaries to include the Templeton Unified School District and the entire Templeton zip code 93465. Eric Hughes, SLO Planning, indicated that the Planning Department has no input into the expansion process. He mentioned that there didn't appear to be any state or county guidelines regarding the process. He recommended that TAAG work directly with BOS Perschong and Arnold to expand TAAG's boundaries.
- 2. Community Outreach** - TAAG is also looking at ways to better connect with the community through outreach, liaisons, and other forms of community involvement.
- 3. TAAG Elections** - Bruce Jones mentioned that several delegates have terms expiring at the end of December of 2020, including his own. Incumbents must make a declaration of their intent to run again at the next TAAG Meeting in December. Non-incumbents have until the January meeting to declare their intent to run.
